NTSSA RELEASE RULES

1. PLAYER REQUEST FROM TEAM

3.9.1 No coach, assistant coach, trainer, or team representative may practice any soccer related activity with any NTSSA registered player that does not appear on his current NTSSA roster or is not considered to be a free agent, except for a coach who at the request of another team's coach substitutes for that coach at practice or games for the convenience of the requesting coach.

3.9.6 A competitive (select) player is obligated to his/her competitive team for the soccer playing year for competitive players (Sept. 1 through May 31) and any release to transfer to another NTSSA competitive team will be allowed only in limited circumstances, between December 1 and January 31 for U11 through U14 and Dec. 1 through March 15 for U15 through U19 through the competitive committee. Any recreational player currently rostered to a recreational team and wishing to be released to join a competitive team may do so only between December 1 and January 31 **for U11 through U14 and Dec. 1 through March 15 for U15 through U19** with permission of Home Association that team is currently rostered.

3.9.9-1 A competitive player is a free agent beginning July 1, until the player and/or his parents or guardian have signed a contract with a team. During the soccer playing year, players are not allowed to tryout, practice, or participate with any other team, unless they are registered as a guest player with the other team, in which case the proper release must be signed by all parties.

4.6-2 Competitive (select) youth players may not change teams prior to July 15 of current soccer year except in extreme circumstances as provided in 3.9.6. Competitive players do not need a release from their current coach to attend camps/clinics from June 1 through July 15. However, they will not be allowed to be added to any team until July 15.

4.6.1 Players who have registered in the current soccer year and have participated in the ODP program may not transfer or be added to the team that their ODP coach/assistant coach participates with for the remainder of the current soccer year, and all of the following soccer year.

2. COACHES REQUEST FROM TEAM

3.9.6.2 A player may be released from a team involuntarily only if the player is unable to play for one of the following reasons. a. The player has violated rules of the U.S. Soccer Federation, USYSA, NTSSA, or NTSSA Member Associations. b. The player has moved beyond a reasonable travel distance. Determination of what constitutes a reasonable travel distance is subject to definition by NTSSA. c. The player is injured in such a manner that the player will not be able to participate for the remainder of the season.

3. GUEST REQUEST FROM TEAM

4.7.1 When traveling out of NTSSA for friendly or tournament games, NTSSA shall allow the use of the number of guest players that is allowed by the tournament or hosting organization.

4.7.1-2 The recreational guest player may not be added to the hosting team's **recreational** roster for the remainder of the current soccer year, and all of the following soccer year.

4.7.2 For all tournament games held within NTSSA teams will be allowed up to 3 guest players, providing the hosting organization allows guest players. The guest player shall be in accordance with the rule **4.7.1-1, 4.7.1-2, and 4.7.1-3.**

4.7.3 Coach must have appropriate signatures before turning into the tournament director.

4.7.4 Guest players may practice with the team on which they are a guest only if the dates for the practices are included on the guest player release signed by the guest player's registered coach. Violators of this rule are subject to discipline under the rules governing use of ineligible players.

4.7.5 A player on a select/competitive team may not participate as a guest player for a recreational team unless the team is playing in an open or select/competitive tournament.

4. PLAYER/TEAM REQUEST FROM HOME ASSN.

4.2.1 Players registering to play competitive soccer will not be required to obtain a signed player release from their home association. (Note: Read Rule 4.2.4.3) a. Youth players not residing in NTSSA are prohibited from registering on a NTSSA team unless the National State Association of such players request permission (in writing) from the NTSSA Youth Commissioner for the player to be allowed to register on an NTSSA team. Such requests will be considered only under extreme or very unusual circumstances. The NTSSA Youth Commissioner may deny the request or present the request to the NTSSA Executive Committee if the Youth Commissioner thinks the request has merit. b. If a NTSSA player decides to return to play in a recreational soccer league, that player must play in their home association.

4.3.2 A team must register and pay all fees and insurance due NTSSA through its home association and then be released to compete in another association for higher competition.

3.9.6 Any recreational player currently rostered to a recreational team and wishing to be released to join a competitive team may do so only between December 1 and January 31 **for U11 through U14 and Dec. 1 through March 15 for U15 through U19** with permission of Home Association that team is currently rostered.
